Procedure for Second In-Course Online Test

The Second In-Course Test will be administered online using the Formative platform. Students and parents are asked to review the following guidelines carefully to ensure a smooth and successful testing process.

1. Location of Test

The test will be completed from home. However, students whose parents have submitted the detached supervision request form from the Excelsior survey document will be accommodated on campus under the appropriate supervision arrangements.

2. Access to the Test

The test will be made available through Google Classroom at the time stated on the official timetable. Students must log in promptly and use the link provided to access the Formative assessment.

3. Opening and Closing Time of Test

The test will open and close strictly according to the times stated on the official timetable. Access will not be available before the scheduled opening time, and submissions will not be accepted after the scheduled closing time.

4. Devices for Access

Students may complete the test using any suitable device, including a laptop, desktop computer, tablet, or smartphone.

5. Login Requirements

Students must log in using their official student Google Classroom account. Access using personal or unauthorized accounts will not be permitted.

6. Time Allocation

The test must be completed within the time specified on the timetable. Students are advised to begin immediately once access is granted to ensure sufficient time to answer all questions.

7. Submission Guidelines

Students must ensure that all responses are properly submitted on the Formative platform before the test closes. Late submissions may not be accepted unless there is a verified technical issue.

8. Academic Integrity

Students are expected to complete the test independently and honestly. Any form of cheating, including collaboration, impersonation, or the use of unauthorized resources, is strictly prohibited.

Anti-cheating mechanisms will be activated once students log in to the test. Any breach of examination rules or evidence of dishonest conduct will result in appropriate disciplinary action.

9. Preparation

Students should ensure that they have the following before the test begins:

- A reliable internet connection
- A fully charged device or access to a power source
- All necessary materials prepared in advance
- A quiet and suitable environment for testing
