### **EXAMINATION RULES**

- 1. Students must attend all exams in their correct uniform and present an ID to be admitted in the room
- 2. Students who are caught cheating will be punished for that examination.
- 3. There should be no borrowing in the examinations. Students should have their own materials.
- 4. No form of communication with any other student is allowed during an examination.
- 5. Students should be present at least 10 minutes before the start of an exam.
- 6. Any student who arrives thirty (30) minutes after the examination has started will not be allowed to sit for the examination, or will be given the remaining time to complete it.
- 7. Students who fail to present a valid excuse for missing an examination will be penalized. The excuse must be submitted within ONE (1) day of the absence for it to be considered valid. If the student is sick for more than three (3) days, a doctor's certificate is required. The letter/certificate must be given to Mr. A. Burrell, Ms. J. Knight, and Mrs. M. Grey-Tomlinson
- 8. Classrooms must be clean and neatly arranged for all exams.
- 9. Student(s) who fail to abide by the instructions of the invigilator, will be liable for expulsion from the examination room.
- 10. No student is permitted to write another student's name on the attendance register. Anyone caught doing this will be penalized.
- 11. Any student who leaves the examination room without the invigilator's permission, will not be allowed to complete the paper and disciplinary action will follow.
- 12. Disturbance of any form will not be tolerated in an examination.
- 13. All cellphones, smartwatches, and any other smart devices (including but not limited to tablets, laptops, and e-readers) must not be visible or heard during the examination.
